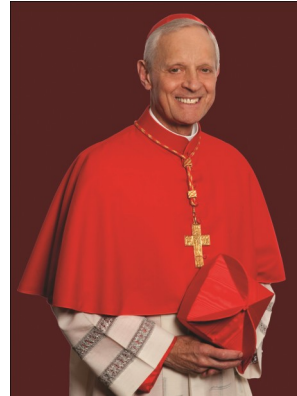

"The New Evangelisation"



Keynote speaker at this year's conference is Cardinal Donald Wuerl, Archbishop of Washington in the United States who will talk about challenges and opportunities the Church faces today in the context of the New Evangelisation and the ecclesial movements and new communities. Recognizing the heightened secular context of Church ministry today, the Cardinal will reflect on what issues the Church now faces and how the resurgence of interest in these movements and communities provides new hope and direction for the future.

Cardinal Wuerl, who was elevated to the College of Cardinals in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI, is known across the United States for his catechetical and teaching ministry and for his efforts on behalf of Catholic education. He serves on numerous national and international bodies and is chancellor of The Catholic University of America, chairman of the board of the Pope John Paul II Cultural Foundation and also of The Papal Foundation. He is chairman of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Doctrine and a member of the USCCB Committee on Evangelisation and Catechesis. He is the author of numerous articles and books, including the best-selling catechisms, *The Teaching of Christ* and *The Catholic Way*. His most recent book, *The Mass*, published in January 2011, explains the liturgy in a way that is easy to understand and can serve as a helpful resource in learning about the Mass.
